What does the programme offer?

Freedom2Choose offers structured opportunities for practical learning, social and recreational activities and access to what's on offer in the community!

Opportunities to do what every young person should be doing:

Learning and development

Each 13-week long programme is themed and focuses on personal development. Themes can include 'Good Mental Health', 'Independence' and 'Keeping Safe'. Young people choose when they take part and what activities they want to join in!

Social activities

Members can enjoy cinema/
restaurant visits and cultural
and drama events.

Day trips

Visit places of interest and local attractions, e.g. Exploris Aquarium, Belfast Zoo and Carrickfergus Castle.

Recreational opportunities

Young people are free to use the recreational facilities at Lilac House to chill or choose an activity of their choice.

When does it happen?

2-4 hours per week (usually on a Saturday) at our South Belfast centre Lilac House (Linked Independent Living and Advice Centre) and at venues in the community.
